

Angling for the Environment

Enforcement

- Legislation to protect fish stocks wide spread across Europe
- Enforcement commonly under resourced across Europe
- Increasingly angling volunteers used to support enforcement
- Examples from England, Poland & the Netherlands











Poland

- Tradition of using volunteers to support the PSR
- Uniformed
- Accompany PSR on patrols
- Over 1,000 trained and many go on to full time service in PSR

Netherlands

- All enforcement carried out by angling volunteers
- Except high risk Police
- Angling body (Sportvisserijnederland) train their Police forces in fisheries legislation

Monitoring & Improvements

In England angling volunteers are closely involved in:

- Detecting and reporting pollution incidents
- Monitoring water quality through the River Fly Partnership in routinely monitoring the health of invertebrates
- Physical habitat improvements with the River Trusts
- Actively involved in tackling Invasive Alien Species





Finland

Finnish Federation of Recreational Fishing

- Monitors indicator fish species grayling, roach & rudd
- Restores and protects: spawning areas, rivers & streams
- Example: restoration in one river by anglers has resulted in sea trout returning for the first time in many years
