

• Evaluating the intactness of Balkan rivers




<u>Class 1</u>: Pristine or near-natural (Vijosa, Albania) <u>Class 2-3</u>: Slightly to moderately modified (V. Morava, Serbia)

<u>Class 4</u>: Extensively modified (Crna, Makedonia) <u>Class 5</u>: Severely modified/ impoundments (Drina, Serbia)

Balkan Rivers are home to 69 endemic fish species

28% of all European endangered freshwater fish species live in Balkan rivers





4 trout species and 17 trout varieties





151 endangered freshwater molluscs species live in Balkans = 40% of all endangered European freshwater molluscs



15 new river insect species have been discovered in last 5 years.








A global boom in hydropower dam construction

-> Initiate a river masterplan with no go areas for dams








Dams in Mavrovo NP: Conclusion of the expert mission: "... the proposed hydropower construction planned in the Park is not compatible with the status of protection of the Park (...); the projects, as currently planned, should be abandoned."
